STATE POLITICS

"I would be very surprised if he knocked Kate Jones off the perch. He's going to struggle big time to be able to get it."

FEDERAL POLITICS

If Kevin Rudd (top second right) still harbours a hankering for the top job he might be in for a sore disappointment.

"I don't feel he will ever be taken back," Julianna said. "I don't think Australians want him back. They didn't like the way they stabbed him in the back, but I think voters were weary of him. They don't care, they're not interested, he's finished."

But regaining his former status could be the least of K-Rudd's troubles in 2012.

"There'll be a leak controversy," she said. "In respect to foreign affairs, I feel he has a mouth where he leaks just a little bit too much information."

"Kevin's a loose cannon. He'll put his foot in his mouth and be rolled."
